# RESCUE & REWILDING

Giraffe have lost over 80% of their historical rangelands across Africa. This has resulted in isolated herds that risk inbreeding, disease, and population decline. Save Giraffes Now relocates giraffe to increase genetic diversity and promote healthy breeding groups. Giraffe are also rescued and relocated from emergency situations.

We are proud to share the following rescues and relocations made possible in 2025:

**SUPPORTED THE EMERGENCY RESCUE OF 26 MASAI GIRAFFE** in Naivasha, Kenya where a planned real estate development cut through giraffe habitat, isolating them and causing pressure on food, water, and other resources. Additionally, parts of the land had already been cleared for construction. Rainwater was running off the cleared land and pooling in other areas which led to the giraffe getting stuck standing in water. The giraffe were **MOVED TO OTHER PROTECTED WILDLIFE RESERVES NEARBY** as well as into Nairobi National Park.

**RESCUED 16 MASAI GIRAFFE IN KAJIADO COUNTY**, Kenya that were trapped inside fences on private lands. Save Giraffes Now and Ramat Wildlife Society coordinated a rescue operation to remove (and later replace) the fences, provide health assessments and veterinary care, and release the giraffe to join the larger population. The team also engaged with local landowners to educate on better fencing techniques and the importance of wildlife corridors.

**RESCUED 20 SOUTHERN GIRAFFE** from a residential area in South Africa that suffered extreme grazing and browsing pressures. Competition for resources led to significant human-wildlife conflict, and several animals had already died. The giraffe, along with many other wildlife, were **SUCCESSFULLY RELOCATED TO RESERVES** on the western border of Kruger National Park where they have now access to over 5 million acres of open park land.

**REINTRODUCED 6 SOUTHERN GIRAFFE AT GOO MOREMI GORGE**, a 4,400-acre community-based reserve in Botswana. This new founder population brought Southern giraffe back to their historic range and gave them the space to grow and flourish in a region that has not had giraffe in living memory.

**STUDIED THE EFFECTS OF NEW VETERINARY PROTOCOLS** for severe, non-healing snare wounds present in Nubian (Rothschild's) giraffe living in Murchison Falls National Park in Uganda. Treated giraffe were also fitted with satellite tail trackers in order to monitor their response to the treatment plan.

**CONTINUED RESEARCHING A VOLUNTARY CAPTURE MODEL FOR GIRAFFE TRANSLOCATIONS.** Previous research by Save Giraffes Now has shown that giraffe can and will enter new areas as they are often food motivated. This research expands our prior findings by testing if giraffe will voluntarily enter a holding boma (enclosure), thus **ELIMINATING OR REDUCING THE NEED FOR DARTING** and take downs during translocations.

**COMPLETED BOTTLE FEEDING THE YOUNG RUKO COMMUNITY CONSERVANCY CALF** who had been abandoned by his mother in 2024. Because of joint efforts by Save Giraffes Now and Ruko, the calf is happy, healthy, and peppy with the rest of the herd.

# ANTI-POACHING

Giraffe are killed by poachers for bushmeat and other parts, particularly in the illegal commercial trade. Brave teams of men and women patrol wildlife reserves daily to combat these poachers, remove wire snares and other traps, and set free giraffe or other wildlife that have been snared. Save Giraffes Now establishes, manages, and supports community ranger teams across the continent that safeguard giraffe and other wildlife.

**Notable 2025 accomplishments include:**

**ESTABLISHED AND TRAINED A NEW TEAM OF COMMUNITY RANGERS AT EMPAASH OOLOIRIENITO CONSERVANCY**, a wildlife conservation area approximately an hour outside of Nairobi, Kenya. This team now has the necessary equipment, uniforms, and skills to protect the Masai giraffe and other wildlife that call Empaash home.

**CONTINUED SUPPORTING THE KAMUTHE WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY RANGER TEAM** that Save Giraffes Now helped establish in 2023. This team employs and empowers local individuals to protect the endangered Reticulated giraffe and other wildlife in this area. Save Giraffes Now also provided the rangers with **MUCH NEEDED EQUIPMENT** to better monitor and patrol the landscape.

Supported Sahara Conservation in **CONSERVING THE LAST CRITICALLY ENDANGERED WEST AFRICAN GIRAFFE IN THE GADABEDJI BIOSPHERE RESERVE AND THE GIRAFFE NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE IN NIGER**. Together, the team expanded patrol range and efficiency to deter illegal activities within the reserves. They also increased awareness of the importance of giraffe and other aspects of conservation.

**PROCURED MOTORBIKES FOR RANGER TEAMS IN KENYA**. The rangers generally patrol on foot only, so motorbikes allow these dedicated men and women to go further distances and also respond rapidly to suspicious activity or wildlife emergencies.

Funded salaries and rations for the Ruko Community Conservancy's 25 rangers after the conservancy faced significant challenges due to funding cuts by USAID. Save Giraffes Now **COVERED THE SHORTFALL AND ENABLED THE RUKO RANGERS TO CONTINUE PROTECTING THE NUBIAN (ROTHSCHILD'S) GIRAFFE** and other species in this critical landscape when other funding dried up.

**SUPPORTED CONSERVATION SOUTH LUANGWA'S ANTI-POACHING K9 UNIT**, a highly trained team of exceptional dogs that can detect weapons, ammunition, snares, and even bushmeat that poachers have collected from giraffe and other wildlife. It is truly inspiring to watch animals helping other animals!

**TRAINED COMMUNITY RANGERS IN MULTIPLE CONSERVANCIES ON THE USE OF EARTHANGER**, a wildlife monitoring software and conservancy management program, and provided the necessary equipment to record data in the field. These tools allow on-the-ground teams to properly record information that could be affecting the conservancies and their wildlife. This information ensures management can make informed decisions and be alerted to problems quickly.


**CONTINUED SUPPORTING THE MILGIS TRUST COMMUNITY RANGER PROGRAM** to protect a small population of Reticulated giraffe in the Kaisut Desert of Northern Kenya. This group also trains camels to assist in ranger patrols, allowing the team more flexibility and the ability to cover more ground.

# COEXISTENCE

Conservation is about wildlife, but it is also about people. The majority of giraffe and other wildlife live outside of national parks, and it is the people living alongside and sharing land with these animals who will ultimately determine if they survive. Save Giraffes Now works directly with local communities to develop sustainable solutions. Water-related projects have grown especially important to promote a peaceful coexistence between giraffe, wildlife, livestock, and people.

**In 2025 we proudly celebrated the following successes:**



**CONSTRUCTED NEW WATER HOLES**, as well as rehabilitated existing water holes, located in the critical Reticulated giraffe habitat of Northeastern Kenya and at Olosira Community Conservancy.

**INSTALLED WILDLIFE MONITORING CAMERAS ACROSS THE ATHI-KAPITI CONSERVANCIES.** While these cameras help the team to monitor wildlife, they also capture any suspicious persons or activities to prevent wildlife crime.

**REHABILITATED A WATER HOLE** in Empaash Ooloiiento Conservancy by removing accumulated sediment, silt, and debris to restore storage capacity and **IMPROVE WATER QUALITY** for all who call Empaash home.

**REPAIRED WILDLIFE DAMS THAT SUPPLY WATER** to Swara Plains Conservancy and repaired a borehole at Kamuthe Community Conservancy.

**COMPLETED URGENT FENCE REPAIR AT RUKO COMMUNITY CONSERVANCY** after the fences were severely damaged from extreme rains in 2024.

**FUNDED A THREE-MONTH PROGRAM** in partnership with the Agency for Conservation and Development in South Sudan to **RAISE AWARENESS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF PROTECTING THE REMAINING NUBIAN (ROTHSCHILD'S) GIRAFFE** along the Sudd wetland.

**PROVIDED WILD IS LIFE IN ZIMBABWE WITH FOOD FOR GIRAFFE AND OTHER PLAINS ANIMALS** after a devastating fire destroyed their dry season's food source. Thankfully, no animals were harmed during this fire, and Save Giraffes Now was able to supplement their food sources with lucerne hay.

**RECONSTRUCTED WATER TROUGHS THAT WERE CRUMBLING** to ensure that they can hold water from the newly repaired borehole (water well) and meet the needs of all who call Kamuthe Wildlife Conservancy home.

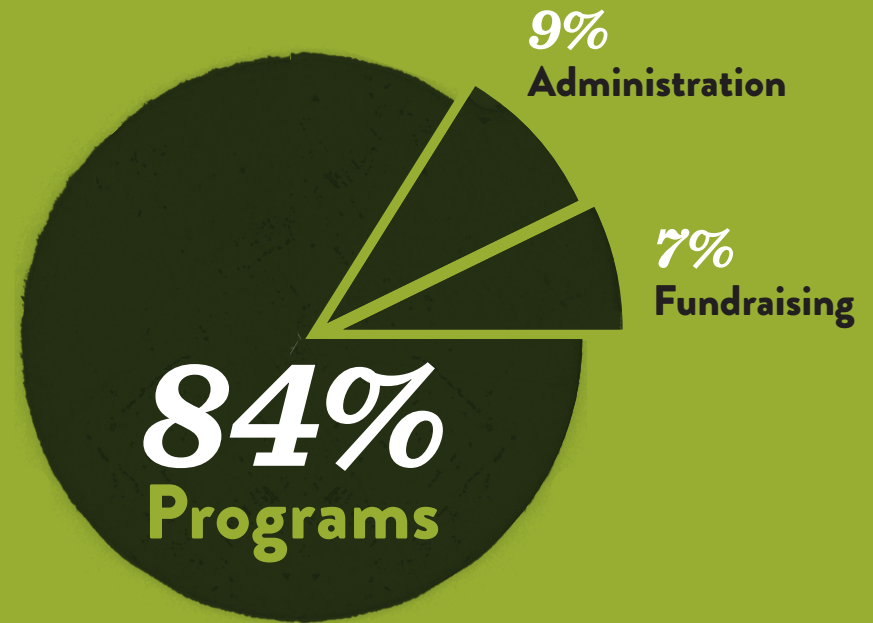

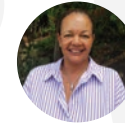
